



Earth Day Contest 2019

Is there a solution to our global plastic pollution problem?

Official Rules

No purchase necessary to enter.

1. HOW TO ENTER: To enter, complete and submit an Entry Form during the contest period that begins at 12:01 AM (Eastern Time) on Monday, March 11, 2019 and ends at 11:59 PM (Eastern Time) on Monday, May 6, 2019. Electronically transmit your video entry link to You Tube or Vimeo to info@reapingnature.org. Carefully review Contest Details for contest theme and entry mediums (song, news report, animation or skit). Entries are not to be longer than three minutes in length.

Entries containing any reference to alcohol or nudity, or which appear to be inappropriate, indecent or obscene, as determined by Reaping Nature Educational Outreach Foundation, Inc. ("Sponsors"), in their sole discretion, will be judged ineligible. Sponsors shall have the right to publish any entry and use them in any media without attribution or compensation to the entrant, his or her successors or assigns, or any other entity. Submission of an entry constitutes entrant's irrevocable assignment, conveyance, and transfer to Sponsors of all rights, title, and interest in the entry, including, without limitation, all copyrights. Sponsors and their advertising and promotion agencies are not responsible for lost, late, illegible, misdirected or stolen entries or transmissions, or problems of any kind whether mechanical, human or electronic. By entering, entrants represent and warrant that the entries they submit are 1) Their own creations; 2) Do not infringe on any other person's or entity's rights; and 3) Have not been submitted previously in a contest or sweepstakes of any kind. Entrant also represents and warrants that she/he has obtained permission from all person(s), who appear in the entry submitted by the entrant, to submit an entry of that person or their likeness in connection with this contest.

2. DRAWING: Winners will be determined by a panel of Judges selected by Sponsors from all eligible entries received. Winners will be notified by email, telephone and/or mail.

3. PRIZES: \$1,000 will be awarded as follows to four middle school entries and four high school entries:

- \$200 first place winner individual or divided equally amongst group participants;
- \$150 second place winner individual or divided equally amongst group participants;
- \$100 third place winner individual or divided equally amongst group participants; and
- \$50 runner up individual or divided equally amongst group participants.

By accepting a prize, winner consents to the use of his/her name and/or likeness for advertising and publicity purposes without additional compensation, except where prohibited by law.

4. ELIGIBILITY: Contest is limited to one entry per person or groups of persons from Forsyth County middle schools, high schools, private schools and homeschooled students and/or groups. There will be four winners from middle school and four winners from high school entries received in first place, second place, third place and runner up.

5. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: By entering this contest, all entrants agree to these Official Rules. Sponsors, their promotional and advertising agencies, and all respective officers, directors, employees, representatives and agents shall have no liability and shall be held harmless by winners for any damage, loss or liability to person or property, due in whole or part, directly or indirectly, by reason of the acceptance or use of a prize or participation in this contest. Sponsors reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to modify, cancel or suspend part or all of this contest should virus, bugs, non-authorized human intervention or other causes beyond the control of Sponsors corrupt or impair the administration, security, fairness or proper play of the contest. In such event, Sponsors may award prizes in a judged drawing from all eligible entries received up to the date of cancellation or suspension.
