1. HOW TO ENTER: To enter, complete and submit an Entry Form during the contest period that begins at 12:01 AM (Eastern Time) on Monday, September 28, 2020 and ends at 11:59 PM (Eastern Time) on Sunday, November 15, 2020, and either electronically transmit your entry to info@reapingnature.org or mail your entry to 2460 Gants Hill Place, Cumming, GA 30041. Contest is limited to one entry per person.

Contest Theme: For your contest entry, in written (poem or short story) or artwork (drawn or photograph), pick **ONE** of the 14 Frogs of Forsyth, and:

- tell/show us something special or unique about the frog you picked
- show/tell how we can protect frog habitats in our community and be good citizens of our planet.

ALL entries need to include Reaping Nature's mascot Echo the Squirrel™.
